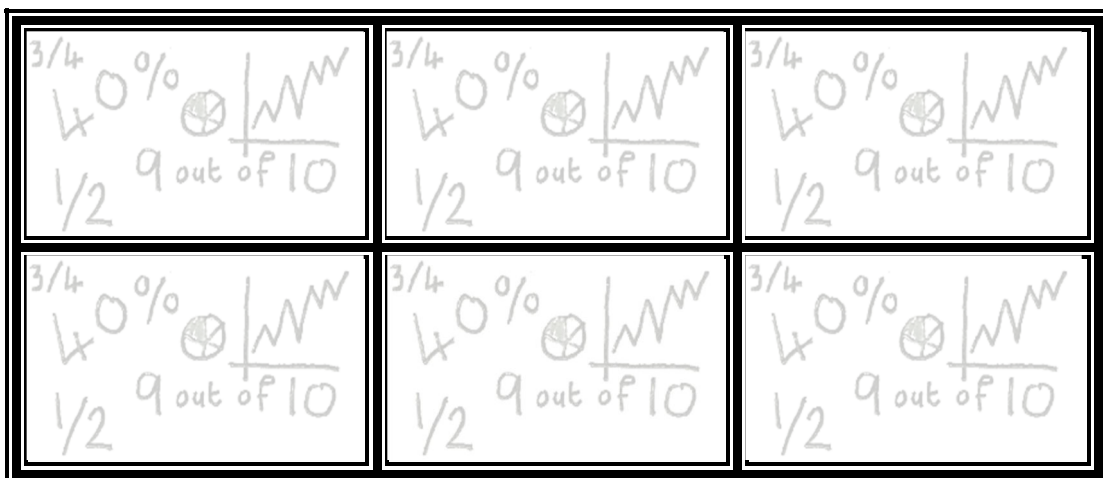
How to play

Census Bingo

The teacher makes 6 copies of the **census bingo pictures**, laminates and cuts out 1 copy to make into a master set, then cuts out the other 5 copies into individual pictures and puts them in an envelope. Each student gets a bingo board and a handful of pictures from the envelope. They choose 6 different pictures and place them face up on their bingo board. The teacher puts the master set into a bag and draws out the cards one by one, saying the words. Everybody listens. If they have that word card on their board, they turn it over. The first person to turn over all 6 pictures shouts "Bingo!"



























